

- Double check your health insurance

Tips for choosing your destination

- Select a location in a temperature climate without high humidity
- Make sure you have easy access to a refrigerator with constant temperature
- Select a location with high hygiene standards
- Identify the nearest nutrition center
- Travel with a companion

How to pack your nutrition supplies

- Prepare packaging that will ensure appropriate safety during transport
- Ensure that your compounding bags are stored in the appropriate temperature range
- Plan a possible delivery of preparations to your destination address

Flying by air? Remember to do the following:

- Contact customer service to inform them of your flight plans and medical situation
- Complete an excess baggage waiver form
- Request a medical baggage waiver letter (if available)
